*(What does it do?)*

<b>Purpose: Reduce riverine flooding risk for residents, visitors, and businesses; maintain natural creek functions; reduce sediment entering Bolinas Lagoon; and incorporate habitat enhancements for fish and wildlife.</b>	
<b>What can flood zone funds be used for?</b>	Total cost
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Dredge Easkoot Creek from Arenal to Calle del Arroyo</li> <li>• Bypass flood flows</li> <li>• Restore wetlands</li> <li>• Maintain channel conveyance through sediment removal at the bridges and sediment basin and continued annual vegetation maintenance.</li> </ul>	\$5.7 million

*(How do we pay for it?)*

<b>Zone 5 parcel tax</b>	<b>65%</b>	\$250/707 improved parcels, \$50/146 unimproved parcels	\$3.68 million
<b>Private donations and grants share</b>	<b>35%</b>		\$2.02 million
