Item 3. Stinson Flood Protection and Watershed Program Update

The *Draft Stinson Beach Watershed Program Flood Study and Alternatives Assessment* was finalized this summer and focuses on flood conditions and describes alternatives that could improve flood protection, emergency access, and creek habitat. The study focused on a conceptual level assessment of the flood conditions from Easkoot Creek and implementation of any alternative requires funding, design, permits, and integration with sea level rise and coastal impacts. The report has been posted to the Marin Watershed web page (www.marinwatersheds.org). A short presentation and flood animation is also available online to help the community understand the study and the alternatives. Public comments on the report are due by February 14, 2014. A final study will be posted after all comments are considered.

A community meeting (#2) is planned for Saturday, January 11th, 2014 from 10:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. to present the study findings and discuss the next steps to proceed. Community support and input is needed to determine which alternatives, if any should be carried further.
