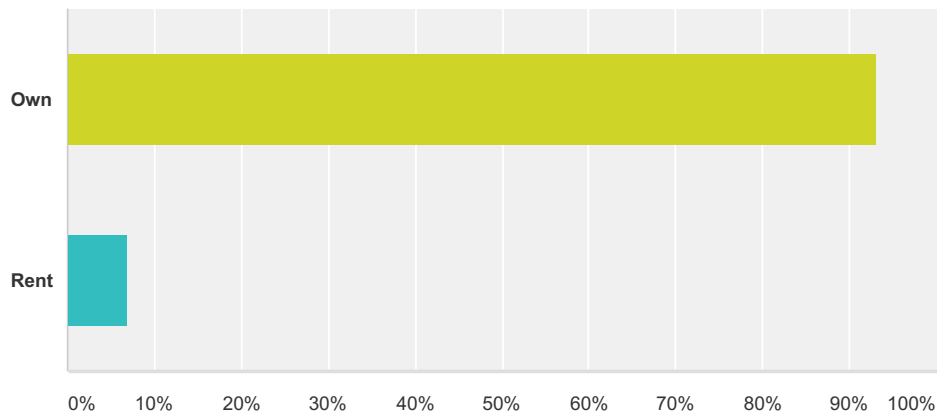


Q1 Do you own property or rent in Santa Venetia?

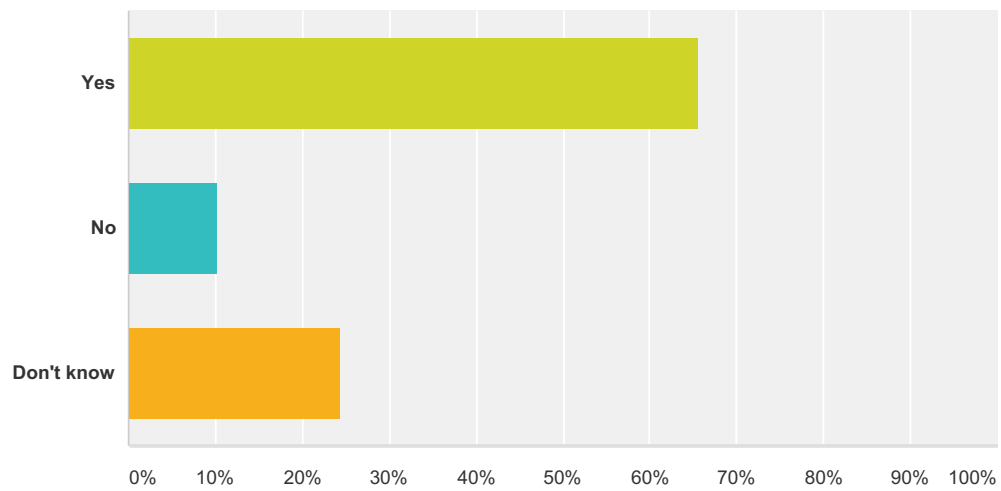

Q2 Is your home or apartment within Zone 7?

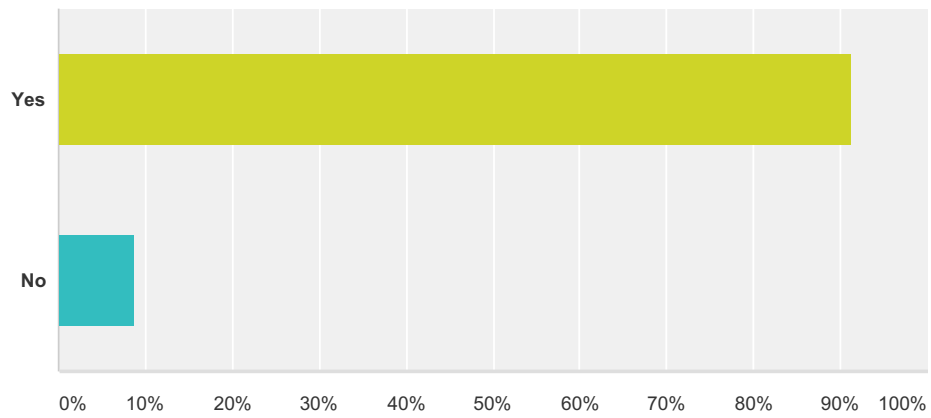

Q3 Are you a registered voter in Santa Venetia?

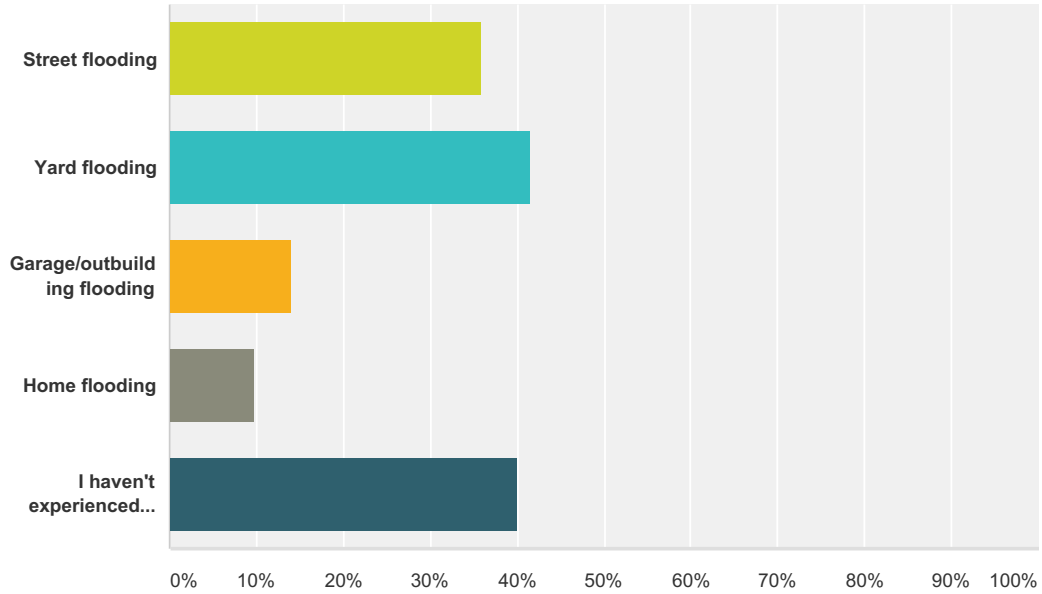

Q4 Have you experienced flooding while living in Santa Venetia? If so, how did it impact you? (check all that apply)

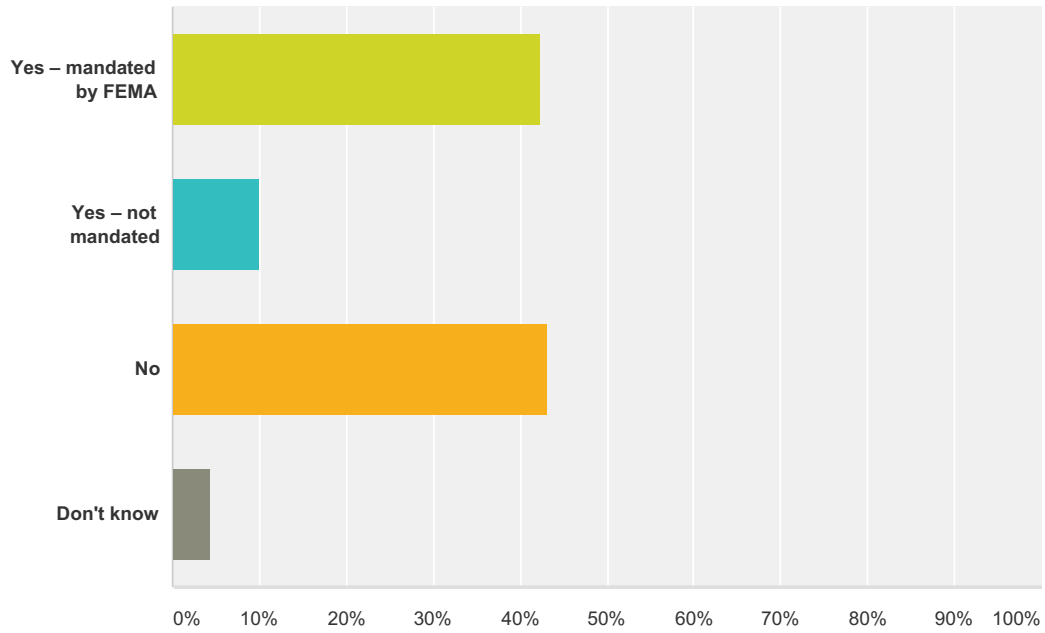

Q5 Do you have flood insurance?

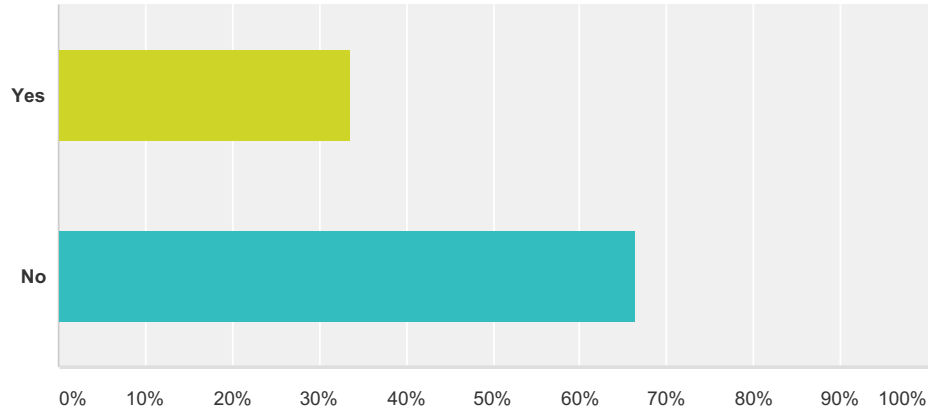

Q6 Did you know that the County entered FEMA's Community Rating System in 2016, which has reduced flood insurance premiums by 15% in unincorporated Marin County?

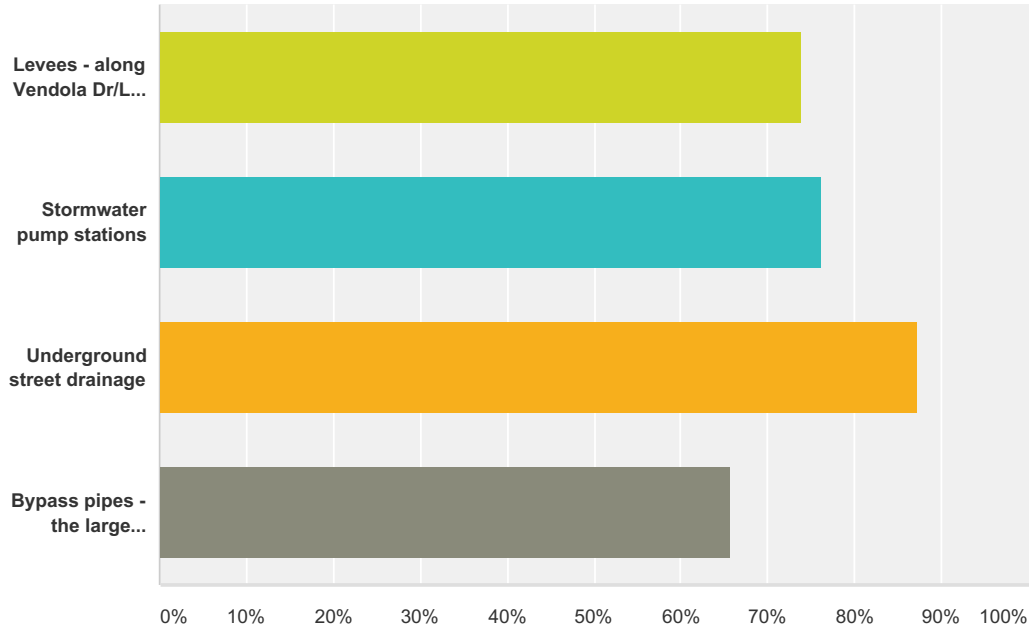

Q7 What infrastructure is important to protecting your property/residence from flooding? (check all that apply)

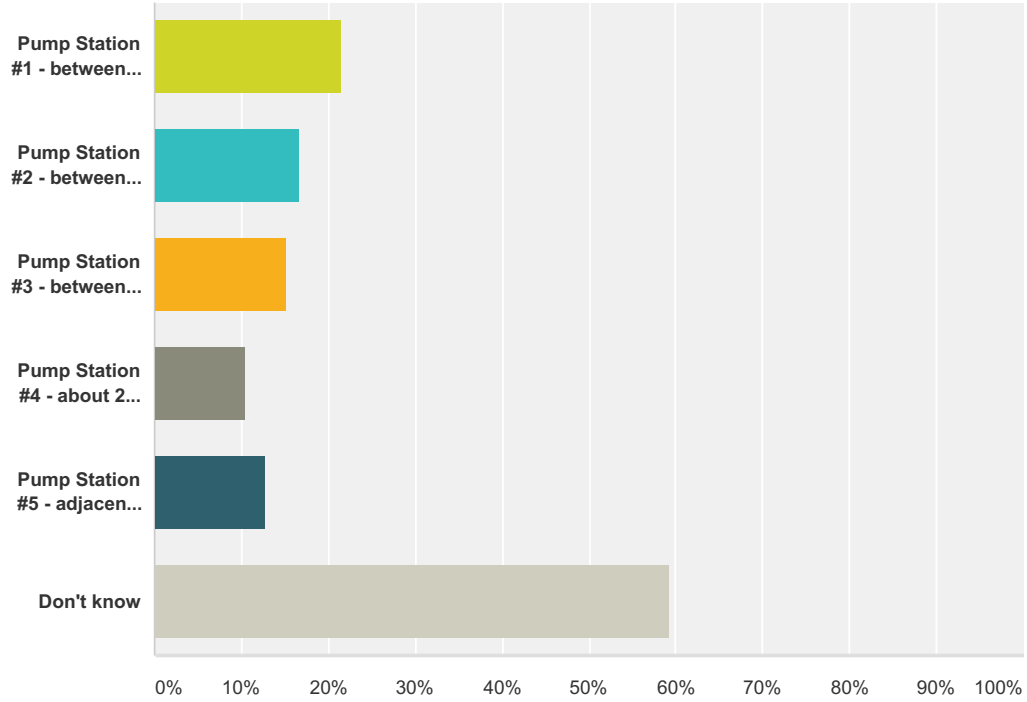

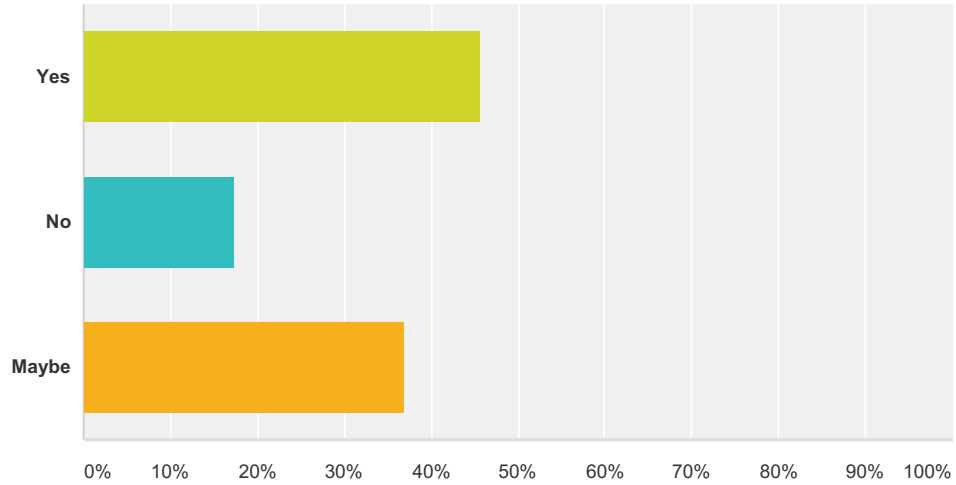

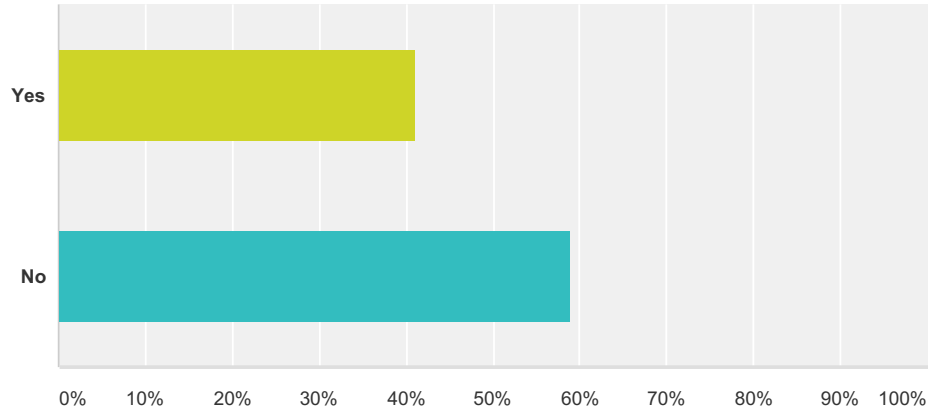

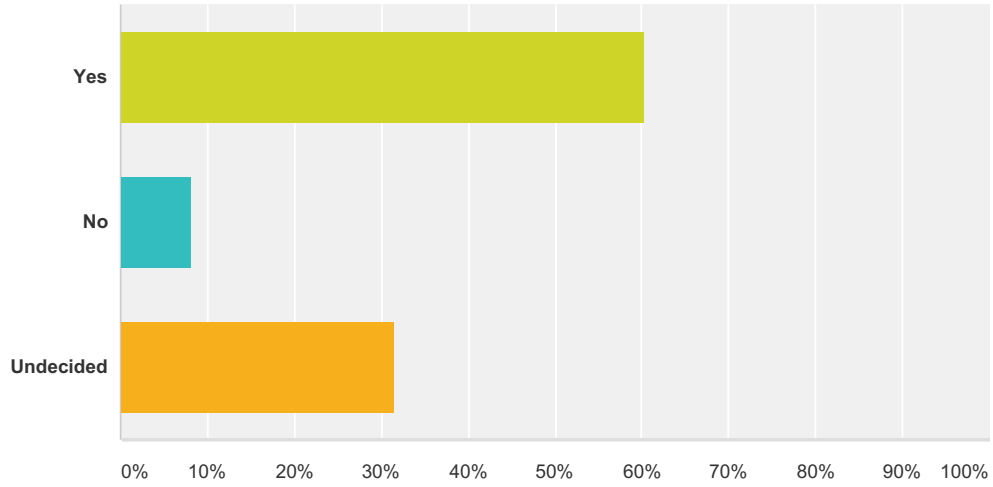

Q11 Would you vote to fund improved maintenance and critical upgrades to aging pump stations and to fund a reserve for critical infrastructure repairs?

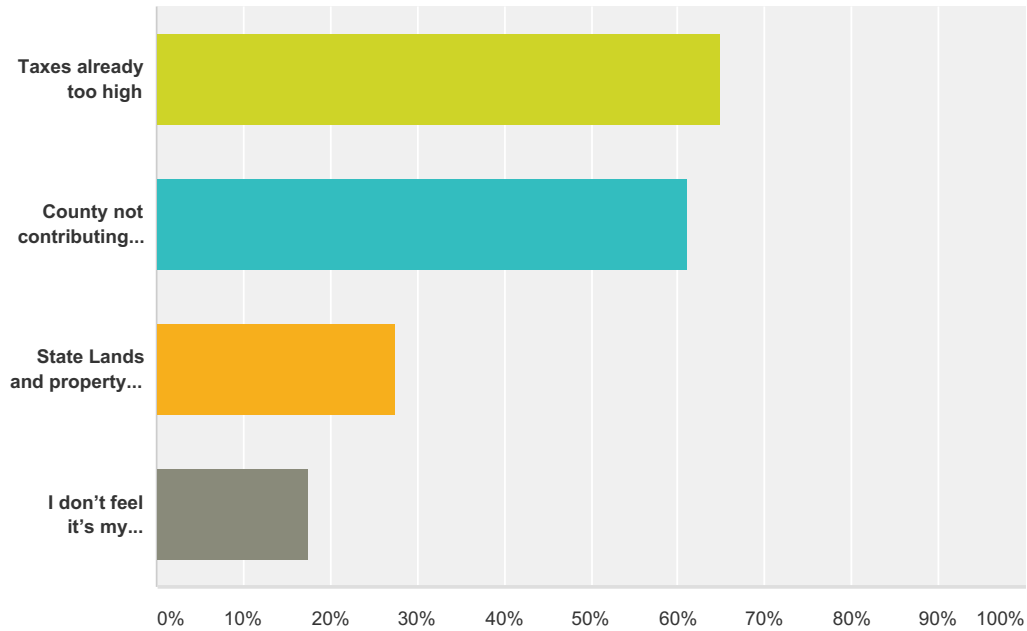
