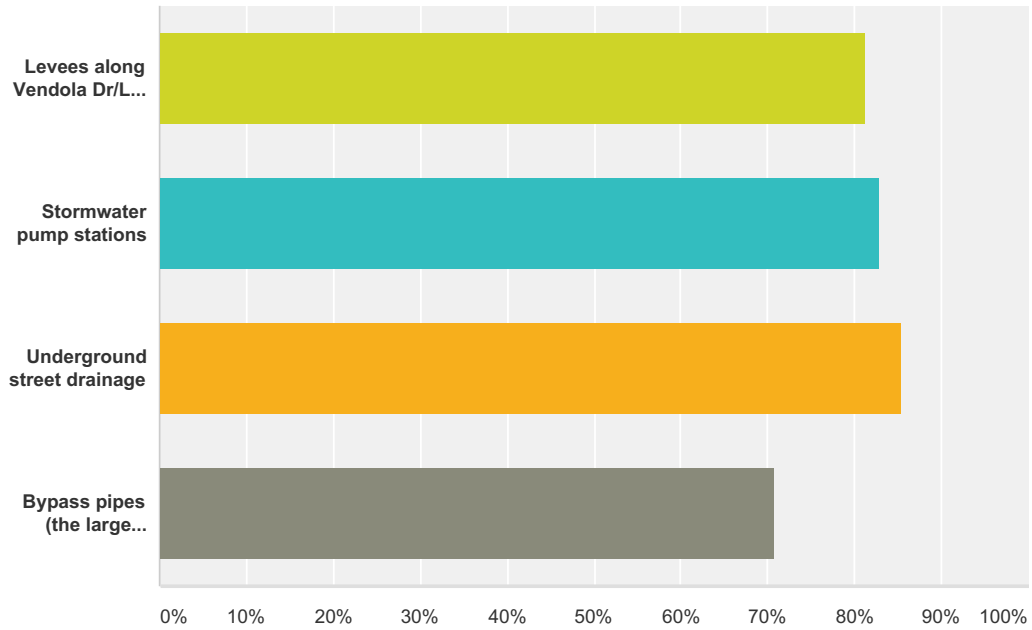


### Q1 What infrastructure is important to protecting your property/residence from flooding? (check all that apply)

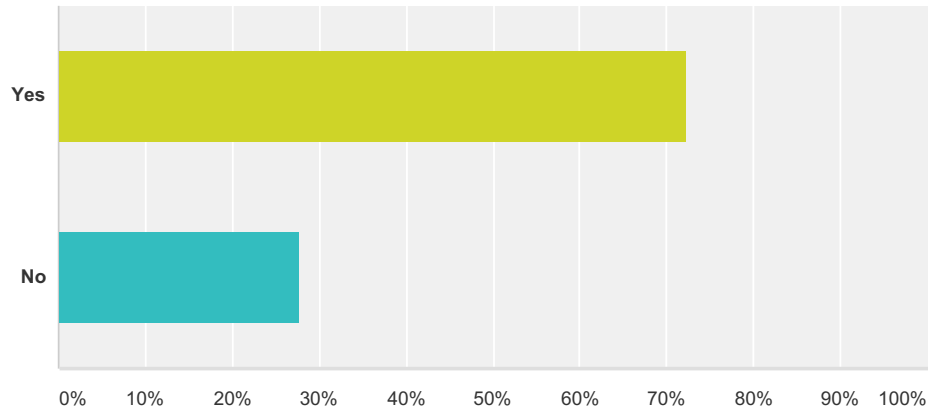

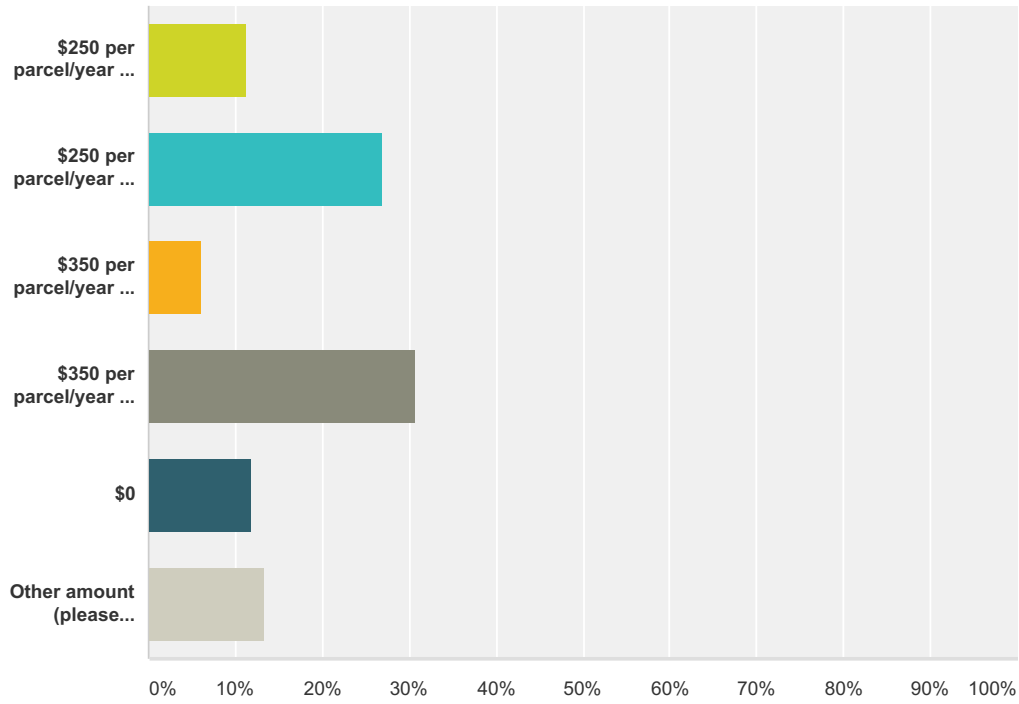

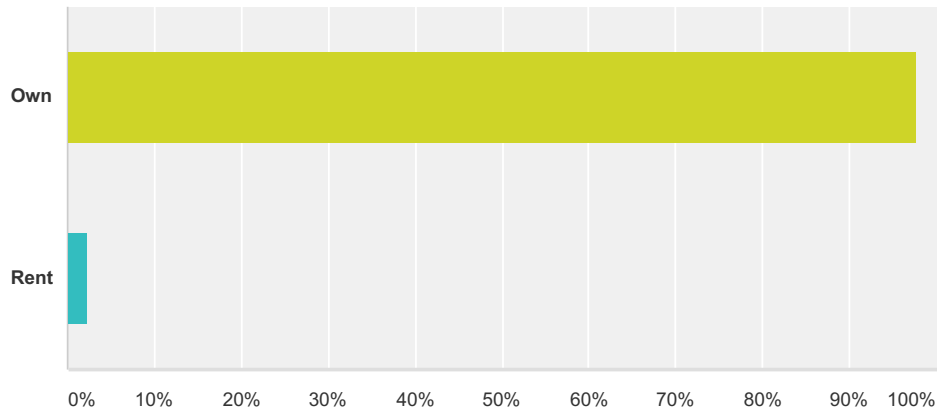

### Q4 Do you own property or rent in Santa Venetia?

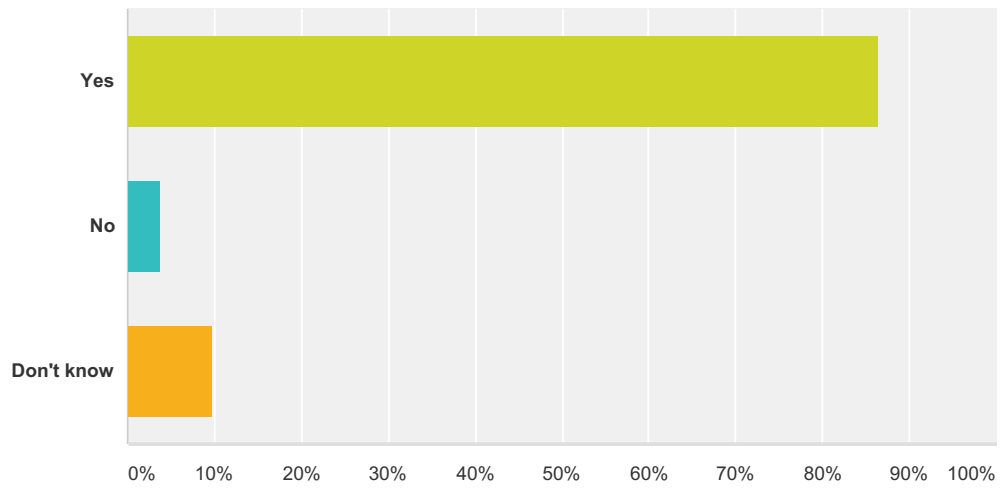

### Q5 Is your home or apartment within Zone 7?

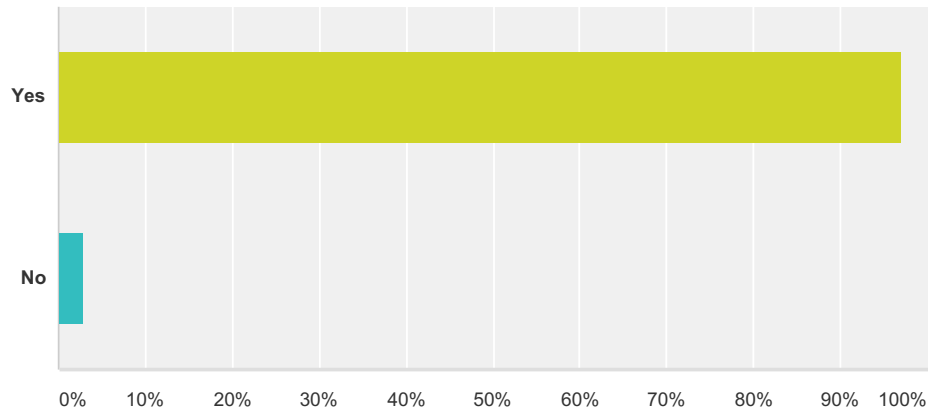
